Audi is setting up a battery competence centre in Germany

Audi is setting up a centre of excellence for the development of batteries for future electric cars at its Neckarsulm plant. A battery technical centre is to go into operation by 2023 at the latest, where prototypes for new batteries will be researched and tested.

<u>Tier Mobility raises \$200 million</u>

The Berlin-based micromobility provider Tier Mobility has raised \$200 million (171 million euros) from existing and new investors in its Series D funding round. Tier plans to use the funds for acquisitions and strategic investments and to expand its international presence in strategic growth markets. In June this year, Tier secured \$60 million from Goldman Sachs.

KIT develops novel method for faster electrode production

Researchers at the Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT) have developed and successfully applied an innovative concept for the simultaneous coating and drying of two-layer electrodes. This should significantly accelerate battery production.

The process developed in the Thin Film Technology (TFT) research group could reduce drying times to less than 20 seconds, KIT said.



Wales launches 'EV Charging Action Plan'

The Welsh government has launched a new e-mobility strategy and presented the 'EV Charging Action Plan'.

It envisions infrastructure investments, including the private sector, to install charging points every 20 miles at trunks crisscrossing Wales by 2025.

Lucid Motors will begin deliveries of its debut Air model at an event in California on 30 October. The first reservation holders of the 'Dream Edition' of the Lucid Air have been invited to take delivery of their vehicles there.

The Taiwanese solid-state battery cell manufacturer ProLogium has closed a financing round of 326 million US dollars. ProLogium plans to invest the capital to expand its production capacities in Asia, Europe and the USA between 2023 and 2025.

Solaris has received the first order of its latest and <u>longest</u> <u>electric model</u>. The Urbino 24 in MetroStyle is a 24-metre "bi-articulated" e-bus. Tide Bus Danmark, active in the city of Aalborg, expects to see 14 of these all-electric buses enter service.
